ELIGIBILITY:

- 2. Applicant must have participated in the V.F.W. Voice of Democracy or Young American Patriotic Art programs within the last four years of high school.
- 3. Applicant must be furthering his/her education as a full-time student at a post secondary institution.

STEPS FOR APPLYING:

- 1. Applicant must write a short essay on "What being an American Means to Me".
- 2. Include a high school or most recent grade transcript with the application. Applicant must have attained at least a "C" grade average.
- 3. Complete the attached application form and include a wallet size photo (write name on back), to be used for recognition only (photos will not be returned).

DEADLINE FOR APPLICATION:

Applications must be received at the above address on or before April 15, 2021 or postmarked no later than April 12, 2021.

- 1. The \$500.00 scholarship awarded must be used in the 2021-2022 academic year.
- The VFW Auxiliary 3723 Scholarship Committee will determine the winning entry. The recipient will be selected on the basis of information included on the application. Only applications meeting all the above requirement steps will be considered, incomplete entries will be disqualified.
- 3. The scholarship recipient will be announced at the Awards Ceremony of the recipient's school. The winner will also be honored at a meeting of the VFW Auxiliary, and in the Owatonna Memorial Day Parade.
- 4. A scholarship check will be presented to the recipient after a certificate of enrollment from the recipient's school is received by the Beatrice Natzel Americanism Scholarship Committee.
