Scholarship Application Guidelines

Eligibility

Must be a senior high school student graduating this year; must be a student in good standing.

Each applicant must be attending a post secondary certificate, associate degree or bachelor degree-seeking program in Culinary Arts, Baking and Pastry Arts, or other food service related program at an accredited college or university in the United States.

**Upon the completion of the first semester in a culinary arts program, he/she must mail to the scholarship committee the official academic transcripts which demonstrate good academic standing (cumulative GPA of 2.75 or better) with the institution.

The applicant is responsible to ensure the legibility, accuracy and completeness of the application including the supporting documentation.

Application Time Line

Applications are accepted year round. The deadline for the scholarship application is MARCH 1st.

The Scholarship Committee will review all applications. Note applicants may be called to come for an interview. If unable to meet with the committee in person a telephone interview may then occur.

The monetary awards will be sent out at the conclusion of the following college semester provided the recipient meets the previously stated requirements.
