


# What does the scholarship provide?

As a successful candidate, you will be awarded up to \$4,000 per year toward tuition, books and fees at an accredited technical, community, or four-year college or university. Funds may be allocated for up to four years based on a yearly review of your academic course load and satisfactory completion of your studies.



## Who is eligible?

You must be a graduating senior at Owatonna Senior High School and enroll in a two-year or four-year degree program in a field of your choice.

### What are the selection criteria?

The scholarship will be awarded based upon a careful assessment of the following criteria:

- Academic achievement
- Personal character
- · Financial need


#### How will the selection be made?

A special Selection Committee comprised of Owatonna High School teachers, counselors and administrators will decide who the recipient of the scholarship will be.

### What must I do to apply?

You must submit to the Selection Committee the following:

- Completed application
  - Statement of your educational and career goals
  - Statement of your school and community activities
  - Statement of how the Owatonna community has contributed to the person you are and how one day you might wish to give something of significance back
- Two letters of recommendation; one from a teacher and one from a non-family community member
